One Year in the Life of Anders Zorn

Dr. Johan Cederlund, Director of the Zorn Collections in Mora, Sweden, will speak at the ASI Forum at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, March 26. In his presentation, "An Inveterate Traveler - One Year in the Life of Anders Zorn," Cederlund will have us follow the travels of Zorn over the course of one year, during which time the artist traveled to Paris, London, Chicago, Venice, Mora and many other places in search for artistic inspiration, new sensations and lucrative commissions. The presentation is in conjunction with the exhibit of Anders Zorn etchings currently on display at the Institute.

Dr. Cederlund received his Ph.D. in art history from the University of Lund in Sweden and has also studied in Paris. Formerly Chief Curator of the Uppsala University Art Collections, he is now the Museum Director of the Zorn Collections in Mora, Sweden. Over the course of his career he has written several books about eighteenth-century art, architecture and other related subjects. Dr. Cederlund will also give a talk on Swedish architecture and design on Sunday, March 30.
